Why are you so scared?

- Afraid of
 - Making mistakes
 - Difficult questions
 - Getting stuck
 - Having miscommunication with students
 - Losing control of the class
 - Being embarrassed
 - Being an idiot







Why are you so scared? (cont'l)

- Afraid the students are
 - Negative
 - Passive
 - Not responsive
 - Unfriendly





Why are you so scared? (cont'l)

- About yourselves
 - Shy
 - Lack of self-confidence
 - Don't want to be the attention of the class
 - Language barrier
 - Cultural barrier
 - Lack of experience
 - Lack of preparation

Tasks:

- To transfer information
- To share ideas
- To ask and answer questions
- To lead a meaningful discussion
- To check students' understanding
- To assign assignment
- To communicate with students
- To perform







Question 1: Why do I have to stand in front of the class to talk? (cont'l)

• Personal:

- To learn through teaching
- To improve teaching skills
- To practise presentation skills
- To improve classroom management skills
- To develop my career
- To fulfill your TA duties
- To earn your studentship







Question 2: How to do so?

- Delivery strategies
 - Lecture
 - Demonstration
 - Discussion

- Contents organization
 - Big 6







Strategy - Lecture

 Clarify information to a large group in a short period of time

Instructor-centered

• Your role?





Strategy - Demonstration

 Transmit the big picture to a group of students in a short period of time

Instructor-centered

• Your role?





Strategy - Discussion

Solicit and involve the students in content transmittal

More student-centered

• Your role?





- Audience Expert Non-expert
- Location
- Equipment Magic B
- Time
- Questions
- Feedback
- Videotape







Question 4: How can I fight against stage fear?

- Comfortable posture
- Shaky hand
- Breathing
- Humor
- PRACTICE (Sorry!There is NO free lunch.)





Question 5: How to handle difficult questions

- Repeat the question
- Clarify/rephrase the question
- Discuss
- Save the best for last
- Be honest
- Be calm







Question 6: Apart from my speech, what else?

- Non-verbal communication
 - Appearance, attitudes, gesture, dress
 - -2/3 of the whole presentation
 - Habitual behavior
